About

The [India's Cup](#) is one of the most recent routes from the Travel Scientists, brought to you by popular demand. Piggy-backing on the years of success we've had with the Rickshaw Challenge, we've decided to revisit our roots in India to come up with a rally experience everyone and anyone can enjoy. While we love to conjure up exciting and new adventures, this time we're going to slow things down a bit and focus more and actually look at our surroundings. Our new Indian rally doesn't take place on the back of a rickshaw nor is it a race, but rather a leisurely road trip in search of the real India from the vehicle of your choice. We'll take 11 days to cruise through unparalleled scenery, engaging in a new cultural activity by night, be it sampling the local cuisine, engaging in folk dancing learning to cook or simply hopping between bars. Are you ready to get to know the real India Then join us on the next India's Cup!

Where?

The India's Cup explores the best of South India going from Chennai to Goa going through stunning South Indian cities, including: Panaji, Hampi, Mysore, Coimbatore, Kochi, Tiruvanathapuram, Tuticorin, Thanjavur.

What?

After the success of the Rickshaw Challenge, our first Indian adventure, we've decided to go explore the country more. Our new rally is not a race, and we've decided to trade our rickshaws for other vehicles to take a couple of weeks of driving and immersing ourselves in the local culture. India's Cup is about slowing down and taking the time to explore and discover a new country, whether it's from the driving seat or by cultural activities by night.

Why?

We love India, and after years of racing rickshaws across the sub-continent we wanted to try something with a difference. You can only go so far with a three-wheeler, so we plan to explore more, see more of India and also learn a bit more about this vibrant country along the way.



Route

Day 1, 22 April 2018. Chennai, Tamil Nadu. We'll spend the day in Chennai to chill a bit and get our bearings before hitting the road.

Day 2, 23 April 2018. Chennai, Tamil Nadu. We kick start our Indian adventure of the India's Cup from Chennai. Starting off from Tamil Nadu's capital, we swing south, taking a long drive spanning 346 km, so enjoy the view!

Day 3, 24 April 2018. Tuticorin, Tamil Nadu. Heading further South, we're going to drive to the port city of Tuticorin in Tamil Nadu, passing by Madurai with its famed Meenakshi Temple before relaxing on a tropical fruit farm.

Day 4, 25 April 2018. Alappuzha, Kerala. We will cross some mountains and a stunning nature reserve before we will drive into Kerala – a state on the south coast known for its amazing food and its backwaters.

Day 5, 26 April 2018. Coimbatore, Tamilnadu. We'll pass by the serene city of Kochi, which has a fascinating mix of cultures, from Chinese fishing nets, a 400-year-old synagogue, Portuguese houses, historic mosques to the remnants of the British Raj. We'll take some time to explore it, before heading on to our destination Coimbatore.

Day 6, 27 April 2018. Mysore, Karnataka. Some say that if you haven't been to Mysore, than you don't really know South India. With a 600-year history and a flamboyant character, we thought it would be a great place to swing by!


Day 7, 28 April 2018. Mysore, Karnataka. Spend the day relaxing in the fabulous surroundings of Mysuru with its Sri Chamundeshwari Temple, the Srirangapatna, and Namdroling Nyingmapa Monastery before it's time to get on the road again.

Day 8, 29 April 2018. Mangaluru, Karnataka. Our next stop Mangaluru, one of the major port cities on the Malabar coast, leads us back to the Arabian Sea. With its rich history it is the hotbed for many classical and folk forms of dance. It is the birthplace of Hulivesha which means 'tiger dance' and Karadi Veshha, 'Bear dance', folk dances that are performed during the Hindu festivals of Dasara and Krishna Janmashtami.

Day 9, 30 April 2018. Shivamogga, Karnataka. And back inland it goes again and we will travel down to Shivamogga where the Shettihalli Wildlife Sanctuary invites you to have a stroll in the forest with tigers and elephants. Shivamogga is known as the gateway to the Western Ghats and surrounded by lush green paddy fields, arecanut and coconut groves, so you really should get out there and explore.

Day 10, 1 May 2018, Hampi, Karnataka. Hampi once was the imperial capital of Vijayanagar, a 14th century empire, and the second largest city of it's time. The ruins are scattered over a huge area, so take some time to explore them!

Day 11, 2 May 2018. Panaji, Goa. Complete your India's Cup in style as you drive towards the amazing beaches of Goa, where in its capital Panaji the traditional closing ceremony and drinks party will be held to celebrate the end of another glorious triumphant journey through the magnificence that is India's Cup.

This is a nice way of saying you'll mostly be on your own. There are no back-up vehicles, mechanics stashed away on the roadside, rescue teams or any support vehicles or persons. There are no arrangements on a national or local level to hold your hand when the going gets tough.

You'll have the rights of being a regular tourist, so you must play by the local rules. This will include all visas, legal and medical regulations. If you're stranded, broken down, injured or harassed, you'll need to take care of yourself and your team.
